Updates from Mrs. Ballmer:

- Spirit Wear Sale Amanda Theisen She just submitted the orders, she is hoping to receive the orders back by spring break. She said about \$4,800 in orders were received, she is now waiting for the invoice to see what the profit is.
- Reading Month Update Laura Durham and Jessica Wood Reading Month is in full swing. Mrs. Ballmer mentioned how great it was to see everyone in their matching Reading Month t-shirts on Friday. The reading group donated 3 copies of each of the 8 books to the library. The end of the month reading celebration will be on Thursday, March 31. It will be a movie and popcorn, with the movie being the winner of the March Madness.
